This kit includes a desk-top sized frame that houses a diorama, two side panels for graphics, and a removable collection wall on the back. The frame has LED lights inside, to illuminate the objects of your diorama!

Choose one thing as the **centerpiece** of the diorama and build around it.

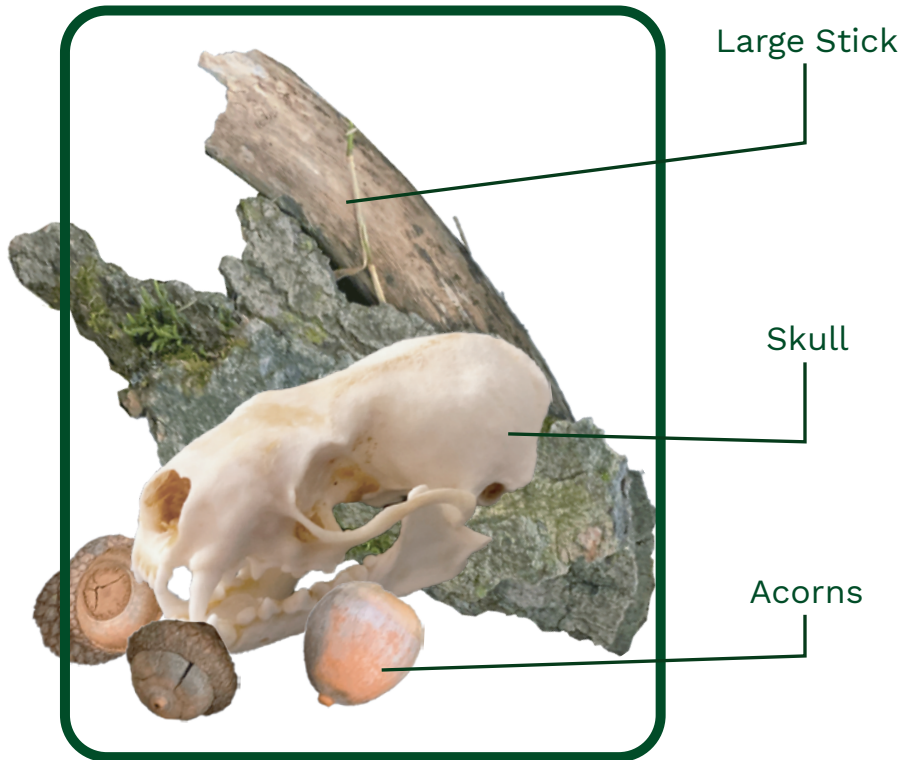
If it's delicate or hard to get a hold of, try making replicas out of clay or foam!

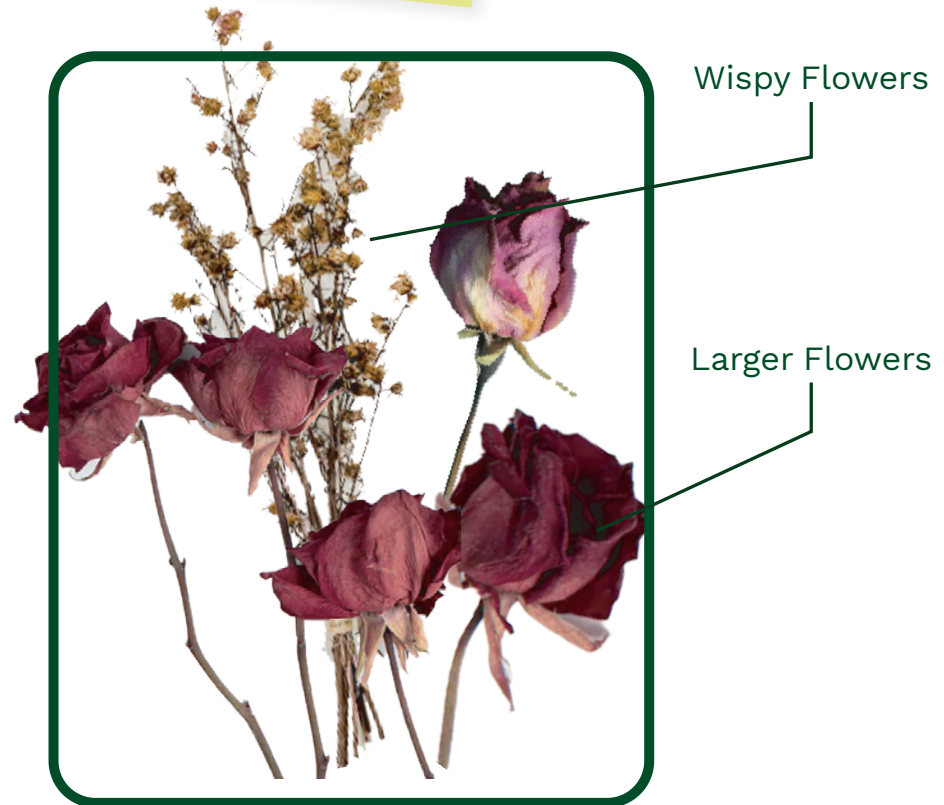
