

Intro to Web Development – Glitch Overview



- Head to lennyroyrobes.com
- Scroll down to find and select ‘courses’
- On the new page, select the course you are participating in.
- This will take you to the courses dashboard.
- Find the lesson you are on and select the hamburger menu button on the top right corner of the course image.
- That button will display some options
- Select the ‘Glitch Template’ option.
- This will redirect you to the coding platform we use, Glitch.

Create a Glitch account

Make sure you’re signed in on [Glitch](#)

- Select Remix to edit on the top right (this will create a copy of the lesson so you can edit)
- or, if starting something else, click on ‘new project’ on the right top corner of the glitch homepage
- & select ‘hello-webpage’ to start a new activity.
- name your project something specific on the top left corner!

Familiarize yourself with the tools you’ll be using

- **Markdown Button:**  will show the code to the lesson you’re on
- **Show live:**  will show you what your site is looking like.
- **Getting back to your profile:** find your face on the top right corner, click on the drop down menu, and select your username.

- **Starting a new project:** Select the dropdown arrow next to the name of your current activity and select 'new project'
- Always select 'hello-webpage' when starting a new activity
- **Change theme, Wrap Text, & Refresh app** Find your avatar/picture on the top right corner, select the downward arrow, and select preferences for theme, automatic app refresh, and wrapped text.
- **Edit profile and sign out**
- **Share button:** select the share button next to your avatar/picture on the left hand side
- **Close Menu Button:** Closes the side tool panel so you can have more time to code.
- **Rewind Button:** Version control
- **Assets**
- **Creating New File:** select 'new file' on the left and name it with the following format depending of type such as: 'new-style.css' or 'new-index.html'
- **Renaming file:** Select downward arrow to the right of the file name you want to change and select 'rename'.
- **Switch Project**
