

# CURATE YOUR WINDOW

## ENTERTAIN YOUR NEIGHBOUR

---

Welcome future curator! Now that you've selected your favourite designer, you can start making an exhibition from home. By performing the following steps, success is guaranteed. Your fellow quarantined neighbours and Lee Van Camp, who now more than ever lacks a platform to show his work, will love you for it. Let's get started!

### REQUIREMENTS

- ♡ Window (in your bedroom/bathroom/living room, any window will do!)
- ♡ Home printer
- ♡ Paper (white, coloured, textured...)
- ♡ Scissors
- ♡ Tape
- ♡ Acrobat Reader/Acrobat Pro

### ARTWORK

1. Select your favourite artwork(s).
2. Open the file in Acrobat Reader/Acrobat Pro.
3. Go to File > Print. The print window pops up.
4. In the section 'Page Sizing & Handling' choose 'Poster'.
5. To determine the size of your poster, use 'Tile Scale'. For smaller windows, you can pick a small size, for bigger windows you can upscale the size.
6. In the preview window you can check how many A4's will be used.
7. Put on 'Cut Marks' and set 'Overlap' to 3mm.
8. Let's print!
9. Wait for the printer to finish, cut out the different pieces and paste them together on your window.

### CAPTIONS

1. In the captions folder you find the name and surname of your artist.
2. Select your favorite font or combine two/three.
3. As for the sizing of the text; there's a wide choice. It's up to you to choose.
4. The QR code and the YMAL logo also come in different sizes.
5. For the QR code, choose the size you prefer. Your neighbours will be able to scan it so to be redirected to our website.
6. For the logo you can choose the complete YMAL logo or just the symbol. There are also different options in sizing.
7. Print your selection out. You can be creative in the paper you choose; think of colored paper, textured paper, or you can just keep it clean. There are plenty of options to make it more personal.
8. Paste the name, the QR code and the logo somewhere near the artwork. Now the artwork is ready for the final touches.

### EXTRAS

1. The decoration part is all up to you!
2. Think of nice plants, garlands, washi tape, candles, ... Go all the way or just keep it clean and simple!
3. Your window is now exhibition-proof!
