In the meantime you can start making your window exhibition-proof. By performing the following steps, success is guaranteed. Your fellow quarantined neighbours and Marieke Van Laecke, who now more than ever lacks a platform to show her work, will love you for it. Let's get started.

REQUIREMENTS

- ♡ Window (in your bedroom/bathroom/living room, any window will do!)
- ♡ Home printer
- ♡ Paper (white, coloured, textured...)
- ♡ Scissors
- ♡ Tape

ARTWORK

1. Let Marieke in.
2. Give her a drink.
3. Ask her if she needs anything else.
4. Marieke will take care of the rest.

CAPTIONS

1. In the captions folder you find Marieke's name and surname.
2. Select your favorite font or combine two/three.
3. As for the sizing of the text; there's a wide choice. It's up to you to choose.
4. The QR code and the YMAL logo also come in different sizes.

5. For the QR code, choose the size you prefer. Your neighbours will be able to scan it so to be redirected to our website.
6. For the logo you can choose the complete YMAL logo or just the symbol. There are also different options in sizing.
7. Print your selection out. You can be creative in the paper you choose; think of colored paper, textured paper, or you can just keep it clean. There are plenty of options to make it more personal.
8. Paste the name, the QR code and the logo somewhere near the window painting. Now the artwork is ready for the final touches.

EXTRAS

1. The decoration part is all up to you!
2. Think of nice plants, garlands, washi tape, candles, ... Go all the way or just keep it clean and simple!
3. Your window is now exhibition-proof!
